




Culture as Intersubjectve Entity

- but it has a kind of objectivity that you can decide whether the answer is right or wrong,


Culture as SUBJECTIVE = OBJECTIVE.




EMS Expanded Mediational Structure




EMS: Basic Structure of Human Social Interactions




Interaction Breaks Down when EMS malfunctions



Social Network Composed of Interactions










